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Introduction

Overview

This IllinoisBID User Manual describes the Illinois Procurement Bulletin (IPB) for procurements of supplies and services by executive branch agencies under the jurisdiction of the Department of Central Management Services as Chief Procurement Officer. This Bulletin contains all notices, including solicitations and awards, published to meet the requirements of the Illinois Procurement Code. [30 ILCS 500]

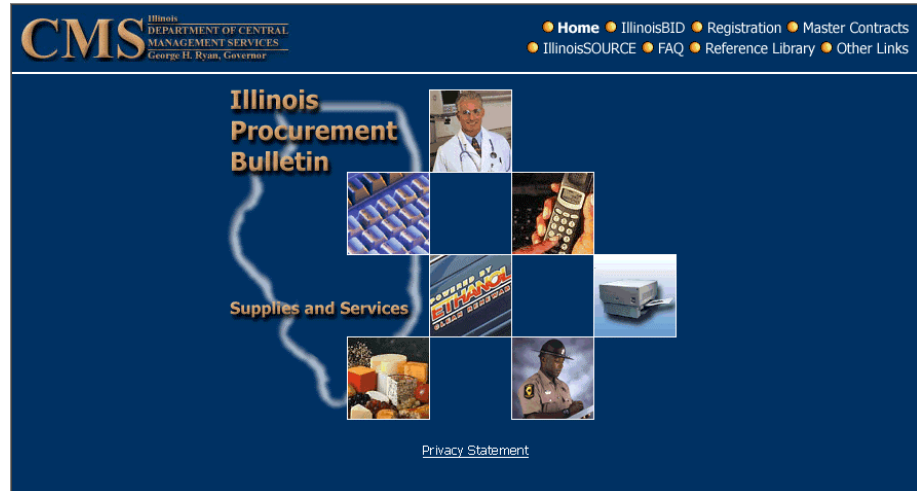
System Requirements

Starting IPB

The IPB homepage can be accessed at <http://www.purchase.state.il.us>:



At the top of the page, you will see a menu of links:

- IPB Home – Will always return you to this home page.
- IllinoisBID – Used to browse and download current solicitations, addendums, and notices.
- Registration – Enroll as an IPB user to download solicitation documents or sign up for automatic e-mail notifications.
- Master Contracts – Provides agency and local government users access to ordering information for Illinois Government Purchasing System master contracts.
- FAQ – Frequently asked questions regarding the Illinois Procurement Bulletin.
- IllinoisSOURCE – Restricted area used only by state agencies to create and publish new bid solicitations and notice of awards.
- Reference Library – This link contains reference documents such as the Agency State Purchasing Officer list, class code descriptions, statutes and rules regulating the Illinois Procurement Bulletin, list of state agencies including acronyms, and the Procurement Services Division centralized buyer’s list.
- Other Links – Visit related state purchasing links.

Notice the Expand and Collapse capabilities. Whenever the IPB documents are categorized, you will see an arrow to the left. To expand all the categories, click on the Expand option located at the top or bottom of the window. To open a single category, click on the arrow to the left of the desired category. To collapse all the categories, click on the Collapse option located at the top or bottom of the window. To close a single category, click on the arrow to the left of the desired category.

The Archived Notices sorted by Class Code contains hundreds of documents. To help navigate through these documents, the Bulletin will display page numbers with each page containing up to 250 documents. The single greater than (>) and single less than (<) options in the list of page numbers will advance you to the next group of 10 pages or previous group of 10 pages of documents. The double greater than (>>) and double less than (<<) options will locate you to the very end for the former and to the very beginning in the case of the latter.

Registration

IllinoisBID provides Solicitation and Notice of Award information for vendors and interested parties to browse and/or print.

Access to this Bulletin is free. You need to register only if you wish to be able to download the attachments. You must also register if you wish to receive automatic e-mail notifications regarding new solicitation opportunities and notice of awards. Otherwise, all views are open without registering.

New User

To begin the registration process, select the Registration link from the navigation banner at the top of any of the IPB web pages. The initial registration page provides information for new users, as well as a place for registered users to get help or update their user profile:

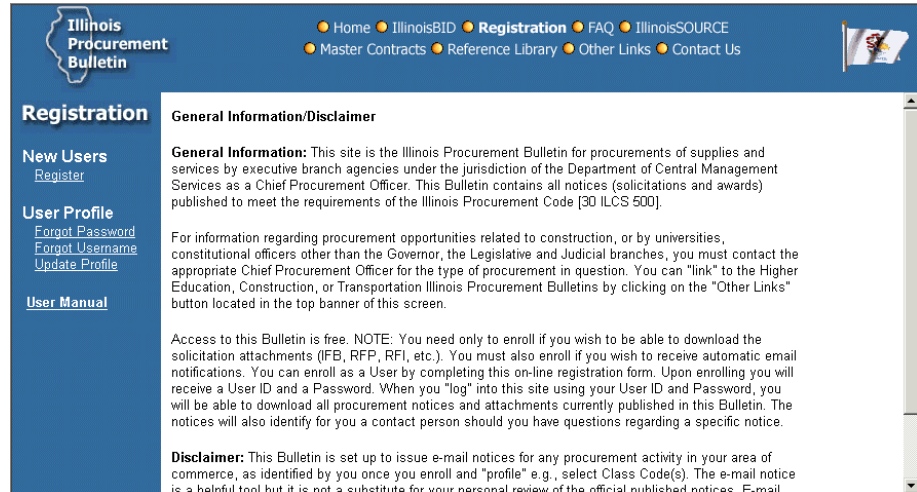

To register as an IPB user, select the Register link listed under New Users.

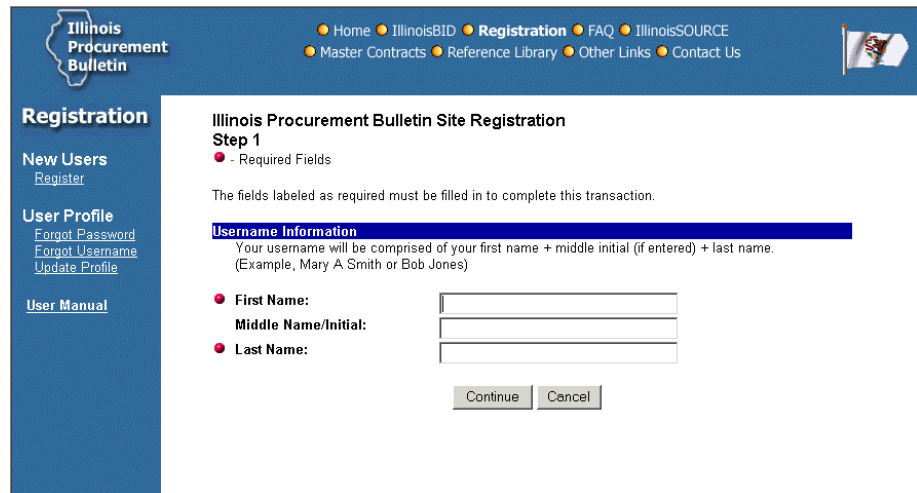
The general information disclaimer explains that registering as an IPB user is only required for downloading solicitation documents or

requesting automatic e-mail notifications. Note: The e-mail notice is a helpful tool but it is not a substitute for your personal review of the official published notices. E-mail failures will not be considered as valid grounds for protest(s).



Step 1

After reviewing the disclaimer, proceed by choosing Continue, which will display the 'Step 1' registration screen. This screen is used to determine your username ID:



Note that red dots designate all of the required fields. These fields must be filled in before continuing to Step 2.

Username Information:


- First Name – User’s first name. (Required)
- Middle Name/Initial – User’s middle name or initial.
- Last Name – User’s last name. (Required)

Your username will be comprised of your first name + middle initial/name (if entered) + last name (Example, Mary A Smith or Bob Jones). If you receive an error processing your registration because you submitted a name that is already in use or not allowed, try a variation of your name. For example, if your name is Tom Smith, try Tom A. Smith or Thomas Smith. You may have to try several variations before an available(unused) username is found.

Press Cancel to abort the registration process. To proceed to Step 2, press Continue.

Step 2

The fields labeled as required (red dots) must be completed in order to successfully process your registration application.

Contact Information:

This information is confidential and is used only in the event that the IPB administration needs to contact you. Your First Name, Middle Name/Initial, and Last Name will be pre-populated from Step 1.

- First Name – User’s first name. (Required)
- Middle Name/Initial – User’s middle name or initial.
- Last Name – User’s last name. (Required)
- Company Name – User’s company name. If you do not represent a company, a personal name is acceptable. (Required)
- Address 1 – User’s street address. (Required)
- Address 2 – User’s street address continued.
- Address 3 – User’s street address continued.
- City – User’s city. (Required)
- Country – User’s country.

- State – User’s state. (Required only for the United States)
- Province/Region/Other – User’s province or region. (Required only when country is other than the United States)
- Zip/Postal Code – User’s zip code . (Required)
- E-mail Address – User’s e-mail address. This must be a valid account in order for your registration to be successfully activated. (Required)
- Phone Number – User’s phone number, format: 999-999-9999, may include extentions. (Required)
- Toll Free Number – User’s toll free phone number.
- Fax Number – User’s fax phone number.

General Registration Information:

This section determines your Illinois Procurement Bulletin registration password. **The password will be case-sensitive when you log into the system.**

- Password – User’s desired password, minimum of eight alphanumeric characters. Displays as asterisks for security. (Required)
- Confirm Password – Re-enter password for confirmation. (Required)

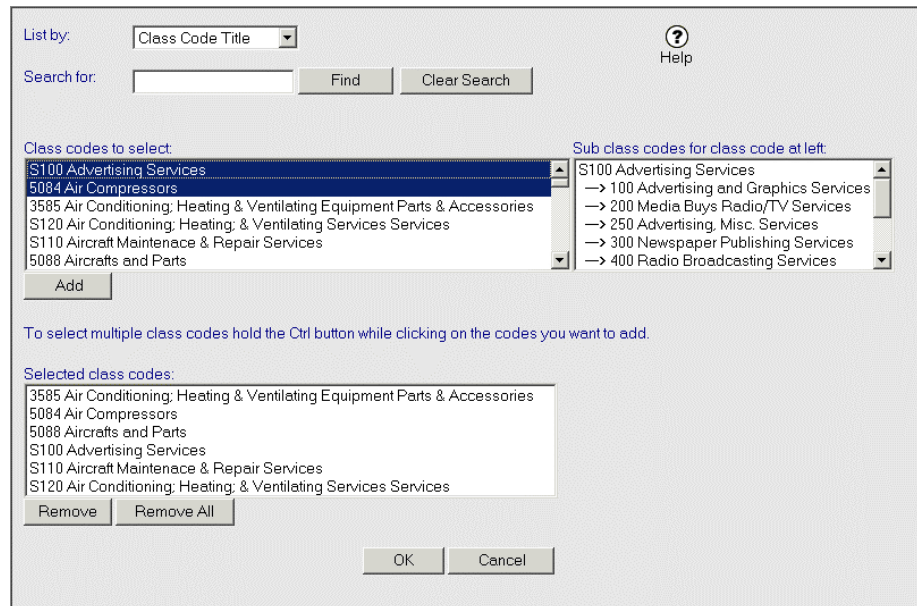
Subscription Information:

To receive e-mail notifications, you must select the Class Code(s) that best describes the commodities and/or services that you provide. You will only receive e-mail notifications for the code(s) and the types of notifications selected here.

To select class codes, click on the Add button located in the Subscription Information section. The class code selection window contains the following fields:

- List by – Class Codes are sorted alphabetically by Class Code Title. You can also list the class codes by Class Code Number.
- Search for - Enter the desired search string and click on the Find button. All class codes matching the desired search string will display in the Class codes to select window. You can also view the sub classes matching the search string by selecting a class code.
- Class codes to select – Displays class codes alphabetically by description. To view multiple class codes, hold the Ctrl key while clicking on the codes and the associated sub class code information will display in the right window.

- Sub class codes for class code at left - Clicking on the class code in the left window will display all associated sub class codes in the right window. If more than one class code is selected on the left, the class codes selected, along with their associated sub class codes will be displayed in the window on the right. The class code will be displayed first followed by the associated sub class codes, which will be indented on the lines following the class code and preceded by an arrow (-->).
- Selected class codes - To select the class code, click the desired Class Code and click the Add button. To select multiple Class Codes, hold the Ctrl key while clicking on the item you want to add.
- Remove button - To remove the selected entry from the window at the bottom.
- Remove All - The Remove All button will remove all class codes from the window.
- OK – Click OK when all selections have been made and to return to the originating page that lists the class code selections.
- Cancel – Click Cancel to close the window without any action taken.



After selecting class codes, e-mail notification options are as follows:

- Receive e-mail notifications for – Select one of the listed options: Both (for solicitations and notices), Solicitations only, Notices only, or None.
- General Notifications - Select “Yes” if you wish to receive e-mail notification for general notices. General notices are used to

broadcast messages regarding system maintenance, upgrades, and enhancements.

Upon successfully submitting your registration form, the following confirmation screen will display:



This page also contains helpful links on how to do business with the State of Illinois.

You will also receive an e-mail confirmation containing your User ID and Password from the IPB Webmaster. This e-mail will contain a link used to verify your e-mail address. You must select this link to complete your registration.

If you have questions concerning a solicitation or notice, a contact person is listed on the main page for every solicitation or notice. You can call the contact person's phone number to answer your question(s).

For information regarding procurement opportunities related to construction, or by universities, constitutional officers other than the Governor, the Legislative and Judicial branches, you must contact the appropriate Chief Procurement Officer for the type of procurement in question. You can "link" to the Higher Education, Construction, or Transportation Illinois Procurement Bulletins by clicking on the "Other Links" located in the top banner of this screen.

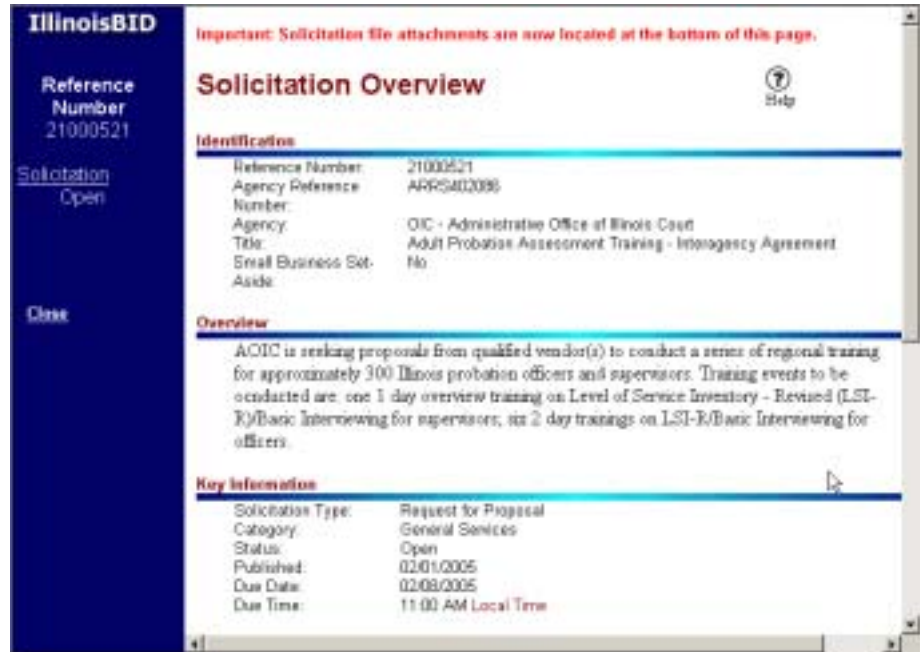
Throughout the IPB system you will find a left navigation pane that provides links relating to the current section of the system. Within IllinoisBID, links are available to browse Open and Closed Solicitations, Open Small Business Set-Asides, Open and Closed Notices, and Search Archived Notices. Closed Solicitations and Notices are ones that have closed within the last 150 days. Archived Notices are those notices that have been closed for 150 days or longer. Also, please note that the Search engine is available to help quickly find specific Solicitations and/or Notices.

In the main document window, solicitations can be viewed in Due Date order, Agency order, or Class Code order by clicking on the desired option.

The specific document can be displayed by clicking on the desired Reference Number.

The Solicitation page displays in a new window with related items listed as links in the left navigation pane. These items include a link to

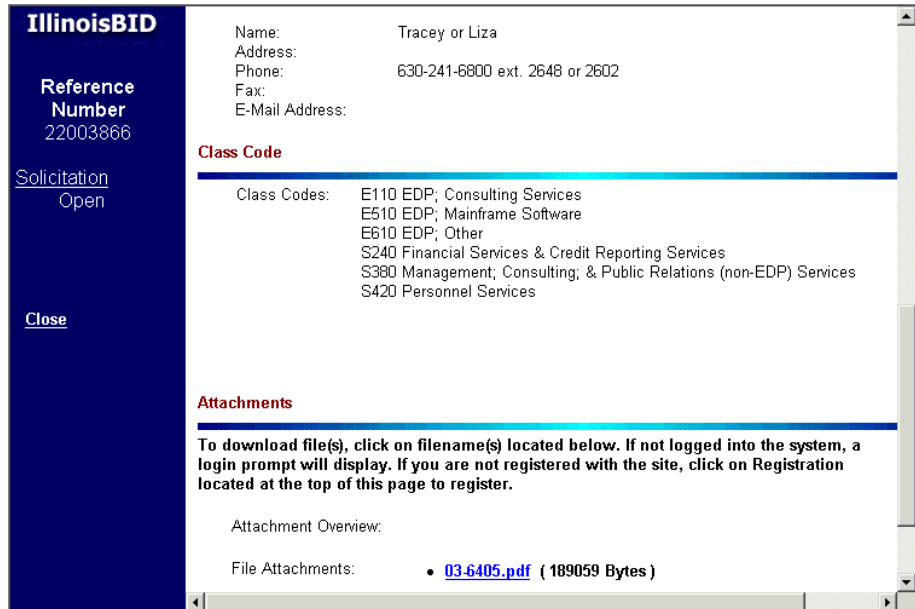
the main Solicitation Overview page and any Addendums added since the original bid opportunity was published.



The Close link will close the solicitation window.

The Solicitation Overview page details the procurement opportunity, including contact information. After reviewing the information, registered vendors may choose to download the solicitation. Solicitation file attachments are located at the bottom of the Solicitation Overview page.

To download file(s), click on the filename(s). If you are not logged into the system, a prompt will display. If you are not registered with the site, click on Registration located at the top of every page.

Addendums

Click on the link listed in the left navigation pane to view the Addendum.

The Addendum displays in the document window with all documents that contain that same reference number listed as links in the left navigation pane. These items include a link to the main Solicitation Overview page and any Addendums added since the original solicitation was posted.



The Addendum page details solicitation information, including contact information for questions regarding the Addendum:

If there is additional information regarding this Addendum, it will be included in a File Attachment located at the bottom of this page.

Adobe® Acrobat® is required to view most IPB attachments and can be downloaded free from www.adobe.com.

To download file(s), click on the filename(s). Not all Addendums will have files to download. If you are not logged into the system, a prompt will display. If you are not registered with the site, click on Registration located at the top of the main window.

The Bulletin will automatically send addendum e-mail notifications to all users who have previously viewed/downloaded a file attachment from the original solicitation. If a user is not registered (profiled) for that solicitation's class code, but is registered to receive e-mail, the user will automatically receive all addendum e-mail notifications for that solicitation.



Small Business Set-Asides (SBSA)

The Illinois Procurement Code established that a representative number of Illinois procurements be designated as Small Business Set-Asides and awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible **Illinois** bidder who is qualified under the Code's definition of a small business.

The default view for Solicitations (Solicitations: Open by Date) does NOT include Small Business Set-Asides. To view Small Business

Set-Asides, click on the Open SBSA link listed in the left navigation pane.

In the main document window, Open Small Business Set-Asides can be viewed in Due Date order, Agency order, Class Code, or Category order by clicking on the desired option.



The specific document can be displayed by clicking on the desired Reference Number.

The Solicitation page displays in a new window with related items listed as links in the left navigation pane. These items include a link to the main Solicitation Overview page and any Addendums added since the original bid opportunity was published.

The Close link will close the solicitation page.

Notices

The default view is “Notices: Open by Date”.

In the main document window, Notices can be viewed in Expiration Date order, Agency order, Class Code order, Notice Type order, or Category order by clicking on the desired option.
